- **Session abstract:** 100 - 400 words w/ objectives. Include a brief description of APA Core Competencies to be addressed in your session.
- **Presenter biographies and contact information:** If proposing a panel, please specify panel lead.
- **Details of Equipment of Audio-Visual set-up required.**
- **Preferred Day and Time:** Wednesday, October 18, 2023 - morning or afternoon or Thursday, October 19, 2023.
- **Note to session applicants:** We may ask if you are willing to accommodate additional panelists in your session if we have panelists with presentations fitting your session proposal.
